NSABP Announcement: Notification of Change in Policy - Monitoring Data Delinquencies for NSABP Studies

The NSABP and CTSU have been working together to implement a process for maintaining high data quality standards on NSABP protocols available to sites participating through the CTSU. Starting last month, NSABP began including on their monthly Institutional **Performance reports notification that sites failing to maintain a delinquency rate of <25% for follow-up data delinquencies are "at risk" for suspension from further accruals to NSABP protocols until the outstanding data is submitted.**

Starting with the release of the February data reports (in mid-March) CTSU will notify sites with >25% delinquency rate that they are suspended to further NSABP enrollments until the site delinquency rate is <25%. Sites will be given a contact at NSABP to assist with resolving data discrepancies and allowances will be made for sites needing to register already consented subjects .

As this is a new process, sites with >25% delinquency rates on the January report will receive an additional "at risk" notification this week.
